A still sweet cider blended with strawberry, raspberry & blackcurrant juice to create a balanced fresh fruity flavour.

39. Mates, Minety – Red Leg Perry (ABV 5.4%)

A still medium perry made from genuine Worcestershire and Gloucestershire perry pears. Aged to give light clean finish.

40. Mr Whitehead's, Hampshire – Toffee Apple (ABV 4.0%)

Sugar sweet cider with a milky, toffee aroma and flavour backed by sweet apples.

41. Sandford Orchards, Devon – Devon Mist (ABV 4.5%)

Rich autumnal fruit with a perceptible sparkle and satisfying finish. Medium.

42. Sheppey's, Somerset – Blackberry & Elderflower (4.0%)

A crimson-red cider with a combination of dessert apple cider scented with aromatic elderflower and with the slight fruity sharpness natural to hedgerow blackberries. Medium.

43. Snails Bank, Herefordshire – Fruit Bat (ABV 4.0%)

Crisp apple cider blended with Strawberry, Raspberry and Blackcurrant. Perfect over ice on a freshly mowed lawn. Medium.

44. Thistly Cross, East Lothian - Jaggy Thistle (ABV 7.4%)

A classic, slightly sparkling smooth farmhouse cider made with a blend of Scottish apples. Dry.

45. Westons, Herefordshire - Old Rosie (ABV 7.3%)

Mid golden and straw-like in colour, Old Rosie is a cloudy, medium-bodied fruity cider that has a wonderful aroma of wild berry-fruits, honey and vintage cider-barrels. Medium / dry.
